**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SNOW PRIORITY STREETS AND
AMENDING ARTICLE 32-169 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE
OF THE CITY OF KANKAKEE, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the City of Kankakee Municipal Code contains certain provisions which provide for parking limitations on city streets after snowfalls, and;

WHEREAS, certain revisions to said plan and ordinance are necessary to assure the most efficient use of city resources in the removal of snow from said streets, and;

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Kankakee

SECTION ONE: Article 32 Section 169 of the Municipal Code of the City of Kankakee are hereby amended and shall read as follows:

Sec. 32-169. Parking after snowfall

(a) After a snowfall accumulation of more than two (2) inches has occurred, no person shall park any motor vehicle or any other object, nor cause any motor vehicle or any other object on the following streets or avenues which shall be designated as "Snow Routes":

- (1) Chestnut Street from Fifth Avenue to Greenwood Avenue
- (2) Chicago Avenue from River Street to Emory Street
- (3) Chicago Avenue from Birch Street to Sycamore Street
- (4) Cobb Boulevard from Emory Street to Chatham Circle
- (5) Court Street from Kennedy Drive to Interstate 57
- (6) Duane Boulevard from Greenwood Avenue to Nelson Avenue
- (7) Entrance Avenue from Court Street to Brookmont Boulevard
- (8) Evergreen Avenue from Court Street to Cobb Boulevard
- (9) Fairmont Street from Court Street to Willow Street
- (10) Fifth Avenue from Court Street to Kennedy Drive
- (11) Greenwood Avenue from Court Street to Fair Street
- (12) Harrison Avenue from River Street to Fair Street
- (13) Hawkins Street from Washington Avenue to Eighth Avenue
- (14) Indiana Avenue from Fair Street to the Kankakee River
- (15) Justice Way (entire street)
- (16) Nelson Avenue from Maple Street to Eagle Street
- (17) Osborn Avenue from Court Street to Cobb Boulevard
- (18) River Street from Fifth Avenue to Pearson Parkway
- (19) River Road from Route 45-52 to I-57
- (20) Riverstone Parkway from Schuyler Avenue to Marcotte Road

- (21) Rosewood Avenue from Birch Street to Sycamore Street
- (22) Schuyler Avenue from River Street to Brookmont Boulevard
- (23) Sixth Avenue from Bridge Street to Seneca Street
- (24) Sixth Avenue from Water Street to Sterling Street
- (25) Station Street from Evergreen Avenue to Wall Street
- (26) Washington Avenue from Jeffrey to Cypress Street
- (27) Union Avenue from Locust Street to the Conrail railroad

Each Snow Route will be identified by posted signs which will also indicate that the street, avenue or boulevard so designated is also a Tow Zone pursuant to this Section.

- (b) After a snowfall accumulation of more than two (2) inches has occurred, no person shall park any motor vehicle or any other object, nor cause any motor vehicle or any other object to be parked on the south side of any east-west street on even numbered calendar days; or on the north side of any east-west street on odd numbered calendar days; or on the east side of any north-south street on any even numbered calendar days or on the west side of any north-south street on odd-numbered calendar days until such time as said snowfall accumulation has been cleared as determined and announced by the Mayor or the Mayor's designated representative.
- (c) For purposes of this Section, Maple Street, from its intersection with Nelson Avenue southeasterly to its intersection with Interstate 57 shall be deemed an east-west street; Wall Street from its intersection with Water Street, northwesterly to its intersection with Illinois Route 113 shall be deemed a north-south street; Enos Avenue shall be deemed a north-south street; Moore Street, Wood Court, Country Club Drive, from its intersection with Bourbonnais Street southeasterly to its intersection with Duane Boulevard, and Gordon Avenue from its intersection with Hickory Street southeasterly to its intersection with the city limits, shall be deemed east-west streets; Sunnyside Avenue, Greenview Avenue and Summit Avenue, for the purposes of this article shall be deemed east-west streets; and Fifth Avenue, from its intersection with Kennedy Drive, southeasterly to its intersection with Court Street shall be deemed a north-south street.
- (d) This section 32-169, and each of its provisions contained herein, shall be enforceable pursuant to the provisions of Section 32-181 of this Code and all other applicable sections of the City of Kankakee Municipal Code. .
- (e) Any person found to be in violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of not less than fifty and no/100s Dollars (\$50.00) and not more than Five Hundred and no/100s Dollars (\$500.00) for each such offense. Said fines shall be in addition to towing and storage fees and other charges described in this Code.
- (f) Violations of this article may be decided by the Administrative Adjudication Hearing Officer as set forth in Chapter 36 of the City of Kankakee Municipal Code.

SECTION TWO: This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication pursuant to law.


