## **Unacceptable Items**

- Plastic bottles and containers coded #1- #7
- · Six or twelve pack rings

- Plastic bags and film
- Styrofoam or packing peanuts
- Plastic take-out containers, cups, plates, or utensils
- · Electronic items Printer or toner cartridges
- Insecticide and hazardous chemical containers
- Toys

## Tires, engine parts, auto body

- · Motor oil, paint, car batteries, antifreeze or liquids of any kind
- Garbage and food waste

The City of Kankakee and Republic Services understand that getting residents to recycle correctly remains on ongoing struggle. Residents need to understand that high contamination rates not only have an economic cost, but make recycling itself less effective. So, when you put your recyclables in your cart feel good about the invaluable benefits you are giving to the environment and the economy.

Please follow the guidelines listed above on what is acceptable and what is unacceptable.

Regardless of why you recycle, how you recycle is even more important. We call all do better at this. If we do, recycling will thrive.

### **Household Garbage**

Your refuse service day is going to remain the same. The cart should be placed out for collection by 6 a.m. on your designated collection day. To keep your cart clean and reduce litter, we recommend that garbage be placed in trash bags within your refuse cart. If a cart breaks or is damaged, please contact Republic Services at 708-385-8252 and a replacement will be delivered to you.



### Recycling

All your recyclables can be placed in the recycling cart without sorting. These are a few reminders about the recycling program:

- Recycling is collected on an Every Other Week basis. Example: If you
  have Monday garbage service then recycling will be service on the
  Monday's that the calendar is color green and so on. According to the
  calendar your first week of service will start on the October 10th week.
- Use the recycling cart that has been provided.
- Break down cardboard boxes and place them in the cart.
- Don't use the recycling cart for refuse or yard waste disposal. Use it only for the items listed in this guide.

### **Items Not Accepted**

Loose trash, dirt, stone, rocks, hazardous materials, liquids, yard waste mixed with garbage, large automobile and truck parts, tires, and other items banned by law from landfill disposal. By law, many household and office electronic items including televisions, computers and computer monitors cannot be collected.

Waste and Recycling Collection Schedule

Service day for regular waste pick up will remain the same as your current day of service. Your Recycling will be serviced on the same day as your regular garbage day, but on an every other week basis.

If collection day falls on or after the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas Day, your service will be delayed one day.
